This program is suitable for previously certified operators who possess good communication skills and are competent on all lift truck classes and attachments used at your location. Program includes an in-class theory component and practical instruction on the equipment. Please note this program does not qualify the participant to conduct the theory component of a Lift Truck operator training program.

COMPLIANCE

- (i) The CSA Standard B335-15 requires that lift truck operators receive retraining on both theory and practical every three years.
- (ii) Safe-Tech programs meet or exceed the CSA Standard and the Ontario Ministry of Labour's, "Guideline for the Safe Operation and Maintenance of Powered Lift trucks".
