



WHMIS 2015 (GHS) REFRESHER TRAINING (WORKPLACE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INFORMATION SYSTEMS)

Workplace Hazardous Material Information System (WHMIS) is Canada's national hazard communication standard with the newly incorporated Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (GHS) for workplace chemicals. This newly created system is for classifying and identifying workplace chemical hazards in a consistent way. It is designed to give employers and workers information about hazardous materials used in the workplace. Under WHMIS, there are three ways in which information on hazardous materials must be provided;

1. Labels on the containers of hazardous materials
2. Safety data sheets to supplement the label with detailed hazard and precautionary information; and
3. Worker education programs.
